ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

The Graduate Council met on September 16 to consider and approve the following:

- New Program Master of Science in Innovations in Aging (GIDP).
- Substantial change to Teaching and Teacher Education MA (does not require Faculty Senate Approval)
- Name change from Teaching and Teacher Education MA to Teaching and Learning MA (does not require Faculty Senate Approval)
- Name change from Family & Consumer Science to Human Development & Family Science MS and PhD (does not require Faculty Senate Approval)
- Name change of Counseling MA emphasis from Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling to Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling (does not require Faculty Senate Approval)
- Name change from DNP-Nurse Anesthesia to DNP-Nurse Anesthesiology (does not require Faculty Senate Approval)
- Policy revision on Repeating a Course and Grade Replacement
 - Applicable to both Graduate and Undergraduate courses – Grad Council approved but might return due to issues with undergraduate approval
