## **ACCOMPLISHMENTS:**

Before winter closure, committee co-chairs sent an email to all faculty (also shared with the all-staff list) about ways to support UArizona's <u>Campus Pantry</u>, <u>Campus Closet</u>, and <u>Fostering Success</u> by donating or volunteering.

## At the committee's Dec. 6 meeting:

- Veda Kowalski, Assistant Dean of Students, explained how CARES Reports work. Faculty can
  notify the Dean of Students Office if they know of a student having difficulties who may benefit
  from Student Assistance. Fill out the <u>Online Referral Form</u> or call (520) 621-7057 to speak with
  staff about your concerns. Unless a course accommodation is needed, the Dean of Students
  Office may not update faculty on the outcome of the referral. This is due to student privacy
  obligations under FERPA.
- Cindy Hawk, Assistant Director of UA BookStores' Book Division, updated SAPC on the BookStores' Pay One Price course material plan, which is an expansion of the current Inclusive Access program. The new program will roll out to all undergraduates in Fall 2023. Some of the key points for faculty to know include faculty retain the academic freedom to choose the best course materials for their needs, and in order for all textbooks and courseware to be provided by the BookStores through Pay One Price, timely textbook adoptions are important. March 17 is the Fall 2023 textbook adoption deadline. If it's not possible to make that deadline, adoptions should be submitted as soon as possible. Faculty and student FAQ pages are in development. Watch for additional information.
