

Changes to Article II, Section 2, Faculty Constitution

Current language:

No candidate for a degree at the University of Arizona shall be a member of the General Faculty.

Proposed new language:

Faculty who are also enrolled as degree-seeking students at the University of Arizona may be included as members of the General Faculty and may be eligible to vote in General Faculty, college-level, and department-level elections. Members of the General Faculty who are degree-seeking candidates at the University of Arizona are not eligible to serve as a candidate for or hold any position as elected faculty representatives for shared or faculty governance purposes at the college or university level. Service as an appointed faculty representative on a shared or faculty governance committee at any level (i.e., department, college, university) requires that the degree-seeking faculty member disclose in advance to the appointing entity, their department head, and to the full committee their status as a degree-seeking student in the specific enrolled degree program, in writing, and in compliance with applicable University policies and procedures, including conflict of commitment.
