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# UA faculty and student data

## Faculty FY23-FY24

- 110 fewer faculty in FY24
  - FY23 = 3423, FY24 = 3313
  - **3.2% decrease**

## Students FY23-FY24\*

- 1780 more students in FY24
  - FY23 = 53,187, FY24 = 54,967
  - **3.4% increase**

## Faculty Changes since FY2020

- **5% increase in faculty**
  - FY20 = 3145, FY24 = 3313

## Student Changes since FY2020

- **17% increase in students**
  - FY20 = 46,932, FY24 = 54,987

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# Qualitative Data

## Teaching

- Increased class sizes
- Elimination or reduction in TA support
- Administrative duties continue but stipends and course releases cut
- Elimination of graduate directors
- Long drawn out process of hiring
- Additional responsibilities after layoffs
- FTE reductions
- Loss of connections with students, with the love of teaching

## Research

- Longer wait times for pre-/post-award
- Long waits of hiring research personnel
- Professional development and travel funds eliminated
- Reduced funding for graduate students
- Reduced graduate cohorts

## Service

- Elimination of service FTE
- Certain service no longer counted
