The Faculty Senate of the University of Arizona is dedicated to nonviolently combatting all forms of identity-based targeting, harassment, intimidation, supremacism, and discrimination on our campus, specifically including but not limited to antisemitic, anti-Jewish, Islamophobic, and anti-Palestinian threats, silencing, incitement to violence, or breach of the peace.

Simultaneously, the Faculty Senate emphasizes and reaffirms that the exercise of Constitutionally protected First Amendment rights to freedom from/of religion, freedom of speech, freedom of assembly, freedom of the press, and freedom to petition shall not be infringed upon by our public state institution or its agents.

The Faculty Senate endorses the principle that the solution to disagreement is more speech, not less, and the Faculty Senate encourages a culture of vibrant civil discourse and lively debate.
