Student success is our North Star for both Arizona Online and UAGC

- AZO Pilot program to improve Guild retention, targeted collaboration with colleges and programs with low retention
- UAGC Three critical student success goals

Online Initiatives #1 Priority: Student Success UAGC's FY2025 Critical Student Success Goals

RETENTION – Students continue through their first year

- FY25 Target: New baccalaureate degree students enrolled during AY24 will achieve a 45% first-year retention rate.
- FY24 Benchmark (AY23 cohort): 41% (were predicted to achieve 39%)

COMPLETION – Students complete degrees and certificates

- FY25 Target: 9,000 degrees and certificates will be awarded in AY25
- FY24 Benchmark: 7,928 degrees awarded in AY24

VALUE – Students earn high-value credentials that enhance workforce outcomes

- FY25 Target: 75% of AY24 graduates will report measured workforce value within six months of graduation.
- This is a new measure. Workforce value is defined by employment in their degree field, increased salary following completion, and/or pursuit of additional education
- At almost halfway through FY25, we remain on target to deliver an additional \$3M in cash contribution to the university's cash reserve at the end of the fiscal year
- No Department of Education updates
- Our focus is on what we can do, not what we can't do (will talk about this more later)

Vision - Deliver an exceptional student-first, sustainable online experience focused on liberal* and workforce education for Arizona, the nation, and international partners with the following attributes.

- Meet students wherever they are in their academic journey with a diverse portfolio of online and hybrid delivery models embodying excellence, innovation, and inclusivity.

- The nation's leader in online student outcomes of retention, completion, quality curriculum, and workforce placement.

Things We Can't Do

- Enroll UAGC students in U of A curriculum and vice
 versa: students must use approved transfer pathways.
- Common Grant Title IV funding in both universities:
 UAGC & U of A have separate OPEIDs and IPEDs reporting.
- Have a Single Accreditation operating authorities require UAGC to maintain a separate accreditation with WASC.
- Add new programs, disestablish existing programs, increase credential levels, or change program length at UAGC: requires ED approval or acknowledgment.
- Market or communicate that UAGC and U of A are a single organization: we remain two, separately accredited universities.


OPEID: Office of Postsecondary Education Identification Number assigned by ED's Office of Postsecondary Education (OPE) to schools that have a Program Participation Agreement (PPA). **IPEDS**: Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System, a system of surveys that collects data from postsecondary education institutions in the United States.

Things We Can Do (and are doing)

#1: Improve student success at AZ Online & UAGC

- Partner with units and colleges to improve online educational programs.
- Work with shared governance to improve the quality and consistency of the online student experience.
- Plan for a single online service center to improve the quality of all online students.
- Align UAGC leadership titles to U of A HR architecture.
- Continue processes to distinguish UAGC and U of A curricula and contributions to our LGU mission.
- Pursue faculty status for UAGC faculty using existing U of A policy and procedure.
- Improve communication about unification efforts.
- Pursue allowable military, corporate, and international alliances.
- Assess and update UAGC curriculum to improve differentiation within existing regulatory guidance.
