Overview:

The committee held its third meeting of the year on November 13, 2024. During the meeting the committee met with Chief Safety Officer Steve Patterson.

Some notes from this meeting include how they are working on ensuring all major buildings are CatCard access by next year (excluding public buildings like the library). They are also working on having locks on all primarily scheduled classrooms and then will look towards smaller conference style rooms that are often used as well as classrooms.

Part of a longer plan, given budget restrictions, are more cameras in areas like parking garages.

They are also working on CardCard access on phones, hopefully minimizing issues like a card being stolen and easing access for people given they typically have their phone with them.
