Recent Meetings (Pay One Price/Library Resources)

The committee held its first meeting of 2025 was held January 22 and we were joined by Cheryl Casey and Cheryl Gerken to discuss updates on Pay One Price, open access opportunities through the library and other materials related topics. They updated with information on OER and the pay one price model. These initiatives have saved students an estimated 38M in last 10 years. A reminder that students pay \$250 in fall and spring semester and receive all course materials. They can opt-out and pay items individually. For students on the main campus, they are in the Pay One Price model. Students in Arizona Online and Distance campuses are in the inclusive access model, but if main campus and AZO student sections are part of one D2L course, instructors do not notice a difference. Overall less than 15% of student opt out of Pay One Price.

Please be mindful of February 14 deadline for summer course textbook adoptions and March 17 for fall adoptions.
