- Dr. Craig Wilson will step down from his role as vice provost for Outreach, Distance and Continuing Education (OCDE) and transition to a professor of practice in the College of Education, effective July 1, 2025. As part of this transition, ODCE will join Online Initiatives to further strengthen our efforts in providing flexible, innovative learning opportunities and expanding access to higher education.
- Effective March 7, Dr. Susan Miller-Cochran stepped back from responsibilities related to the Office of General Education, where she has served as founding Executive Director. She will return to her position as a tenured professor in the English department and will continue to serve on Faculty Senate.

- Dr. Chrissy Liberman has been appointed as the Dean of Students effective April 14, 2025. Dr. Liberman has been serving in the interim role since Aug. 12, 2024. She was previously the associate dean of students.
