Organizational/Leadership Updates

- Effective immediately, Dr. Jennifer Barton has agreed to serve as the Interim Vice Provost for Health Programs, reporting to the Provost. She will oversee the research and administrative functions currently within the Health Sciences.
- The Health Science Colleges will now report to the Provost. All current academic programs, course offerings, faculty shared governance, and promotion and tenure criteria will remain unchanged in these colleges.
- Academic Unit Integrations <u>announced</u> on April 16th:
 - Integration of the College of Health Sciences with the Mel and Enid Zuckerman College of Public Health, effective July 1.
 - Integration of the College of Applied Science and Technology into the College of Information Science, effective July 1.
- School of Mining Engineering and Mineral Resources:
 - The School of Mining and Mineral Resources (SMMR) will formally merge with Mining and Geological Engineering (MGE) to form the School of Mining Engineering and Mineral Resources, effective July 1, 2025.

Search Updates

Admissions Process Changes for Fall 2026

- These changes apply only to Main Campus First Year incoming degree seeking students.
- The Fall 2026 application will go live on August 1, 2025
- November 1, 2025, will be the Early Action deadline for admission, merit scholarship consideration and honors admission.
 - Applications received between August 1 and November 1 will receive their decisions on January 15, 2026.
- After November 1 applications will be considered Regular Decision.
 - Regular Decisions for applications received after November 1 through the end of January will be released mid-February
 - Regular Decisions for applications received from February through March will be released at the end of March

- These changes will not impact need-based aid packaging timelines.
- All applications and scholarship consideration will be based on a holistic review of the application and supporting materials. There will not be any auto-admitted or awarded processes as with the past practices.
- There will be no changes to the application processes for any other populations.
