- Follow up on student feedback

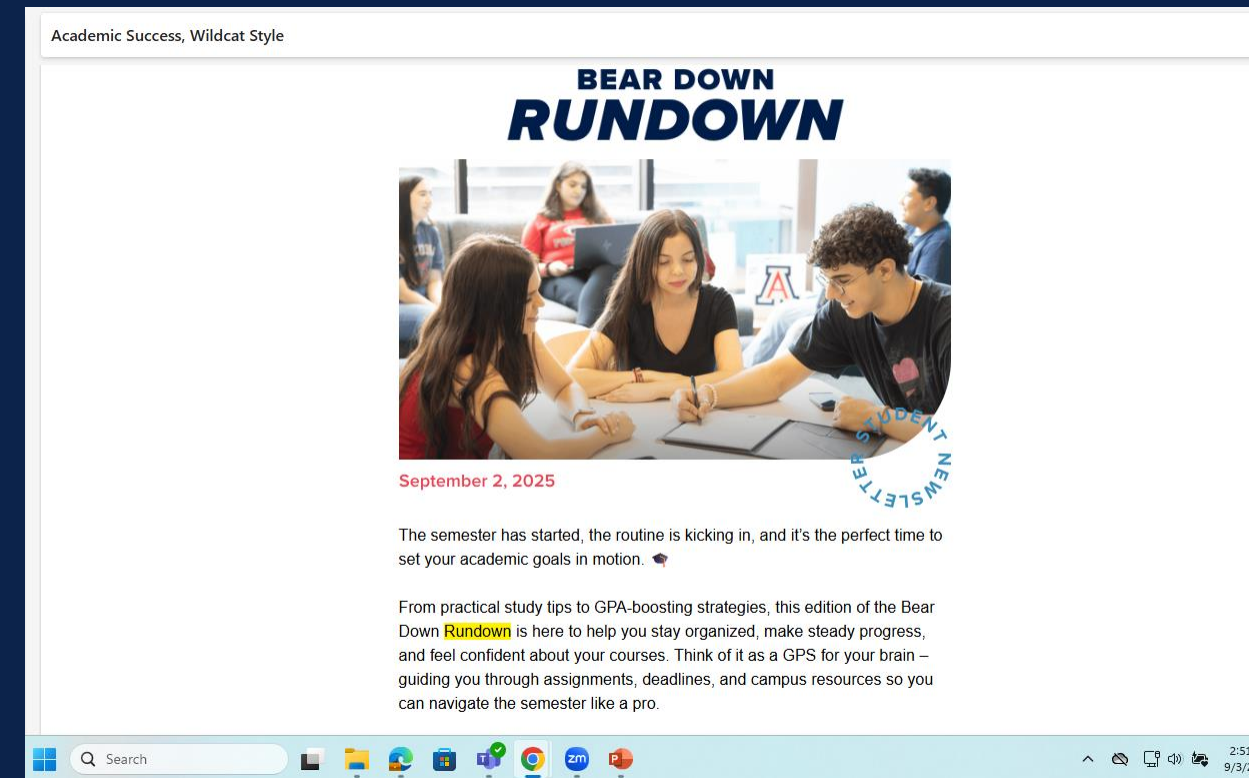
