

Ongoing Efforts

- Developing processes for transition to new titles for Career Track Faculty with the goal to complete by Fall 2021, allowing pay equity review to proceed.
- Course Support for Caregiving Instructors: As of April 2, 2021, awarded \$338,537 to instructors in 11 colleges for <u>supports</u> for grading, online content development, online teaching, and technology costs.
- Working with <u>PAC</u> to put together **Academic Instruction Guidance for Summer 2021 and** Fall 2021.
- Modifications to RCM: Asked Colleges to establish AIB Working Groups to provide Collegelevel review and feedback on possible changes to budget model and to develop / review activity-based operational support distributions to individual departments.
